Club Descriptions:

Story box club: we read a book and then the children create a 'room' using different materials around the theme of the story. We will do about 3-4 projects over the 10 weeks. Children will need to use their imagination to create a box that incorporates the theme and purpose of the story.

During **dance club** we will work as a team to choreograph a dance ready to perform during the final week. The children will also have freedom to choose style and song to perform to.

Construction club – We will be building and exploring with lego and blocks. Each week there will be a different focus and challenge e.g. People who help us - police station, hospitals, schools, animals, tallest tower challenge, bridges etc.

In **art club**, we will be looking at a range of techniques using a variety of materials. The children will have the opportunity to draw, paint and create objects, focusing on a different theme every week. They will also see an array of art from multiple artists to help inspire the children's creative side.

During **cookery club** we will explore different foods. Each week we will prepare or bake sweet and savoury treats. We will discuss healthy and unhealthy foods and of course taste lots of yummy dishes!

Science – We will be taking part in a variety of experiments that will lead to a recognised Crest Award Certificate. The cost for this award is £1 per child so this club will be at the cost of £6 instead of £5.

Yoga – During yoga club we will be watching cosmic yoga videos and practicing different yoga poses and mindfulness activities.

Playground games – This will be an opportunity for the children to get involved in 'old school' playground games such as 'duck duck goose', and 'what's the time mr wolf'. They will also be able to share any game ideas they have and create their own games.

Programming – Developing computer programming skills using school computer equipment.
